*Residents Provided Options to Recycle Holiday Trees*

**Meridian Township, MI** – Meridian Township is accepting Christmas trees for disposal from December 26th to January 31st in Nancy Moore Park (1960 Gaylord C. Smith Court, Haslett). Trees may be dropped off at no charge.

Trees should be free of:

- Wire
- Metal Bracing
- Nails
- Plastic Bags

\*Wreaths will not be accepted

Trees can also be recycled at the Meridian Township Recycling Center (5976 E. Lake Drive, Haslett). Fees may apply:

- \$5 for standard 6 foot tree
- \$10 for larger trees
- No lights, metal, wire or decorations
- \$5 for artificial trees
