3A. Approval of Minutes

3B. 2022 PROJECTS UPDATE

The committee discussed the following lake projects:

- The natural shoreline demonstration project: EGLE permit has not been issued yet; this will delay the bid letting to mid-October at the earliest. Due to the permit delay, As such, it has been agreed that work on this project will be specified for construction during next spring.
- The shoreline survey status was not clear at the time of the meeting; Younes was to follow up with consultant on when to expect the report.

- Second Harvest: The consensus of the committee was not to initiate a request for the second harvest, unless the consultant finds that it is warranted.
- Water sampling: Curt stated that he had called the golf course owner to discuss use of fertilizers but he could not reach him.

3C. PARK MANAGER REPORT

Park Manger Emens reported to the committee the following:

- ICP have been discussing posting “NO HUNTING” signs within county parks area, and that they would like to use signs that are similar to the Township’s.
- The boat launch contract has been awarded to “Laux” Construction. He added that work on the boat ramp would start in late October. He added that the ramp layout would stay the same with one dock.
- The deer-hunting program will begin in October.
