1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chair Armbruster called the meeting to order at **5:30 pm.**

3A. Approval of Minutes

The May minutes were approved as submitted.

3B. TIER 1 MEMBER VACANCY

Younes informed the committee that only one eligible candidate, Mr. Roger Taylor, had filed to fill the vacant Tier 1 vacancy. After a brief discussion, the committee voted unanimously to recommend to the Township Board that Mr. Taylor be appointed to fill the vacancy in Tier 1 and serve the remaining term.

3C. SUMMER NEWSLETTER

The committee reviewed a draft prepared by Lake Consultant and then voted unanimously to approve it for distribution to Tier 1 & 2 property owners. Younes informed the committee that the newsletter would be mailed this week.

3d. AQUATIC PLANT CONTROL UPDATE

Chair Armbruster stated that the lake was treated on May 20 and the consultant is planned to conduct a follow up survey on June 16. He also added that from all indications the herbicide treatment appeared to have been successful.

3E. PARK MANAGER'S REPORT

Park Manager Coe Stated that he only had one item to discuss.

He stated that the Houghton Lake group wanted to donate two portable power wash machines that they do not need anymore. Upon looking in to the matter closely, Coe mentioned that the machines would be operated by volunteers and he also thought that the machine would require a lot of maintenance. As such, his recommendation was not to accept the donated equipment. The committee agreed.

3F. MISCELLANEOUS:

Chair Armbruster suggested that one thing that can be done to mitigate the impact of wake boats is to provide a depth map near the boat launch. This would allow wake boaters locate the deep areas and keep away from the shallow areas near the shoreline. He added that he will work with the LLOPOA AND THE Park Manger to get the map display built.
