1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

3A. Approval of Minutes

The March 12, 2019 meeting minutes were approved as submitted.

3B. New Ingham County Parks Representative

Coe Emens introduced himself as the new Lake Lansing Park Manager and the ICP representative on the advisory committee. The committee then went over items that the previous Manager was working on including the following: Use the natural resource definition to apply to lake water in order to restrict commercial withdrawal of lake Lansing; boat launch upgrades; implementation of new boat law regarding invasive species control. In addition to these items Coe informed the committee that he has a meeting coming up with LLPOA and volunteers to coordinate this year's goose control.

3C. Committee Membership

3D. Secci Disk Measurement

Chair Armbruster stated that he received training from the Lake consultant on how to use the secci disk to measure water clarity. Two to eight secci measurements are now required by the state as a condition for this year's herbicide treatment.

3E. Dam & Lake Level Status

Chair Armbruster reported to the committee that ICDC installed a board at the dam, and measured the lake level at 851.96'.

3F. Herbicide Treatment

Chair Armbruster also reported that the lake consultant was surveying the lake to determine the herbicide dosage for the pending treatment. It was noted the notifications have not been sent out yet, but will be sent out and posted before the application.

3F. Miscellaneous

Coe shared with the committee that Lake Lansing North will undergo ADA improvements to the restrooms and at the entrance near the marshy area.
