1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

3A. APPROVAL OF FEBRUARY MEETING MINUTES

The draft February minutes were discussed and then were unanimously approved, with one correction to the attendees' list.

3B. CHAIRMAN REMARKS

Chair Armbruster shared with the committee the following updates:

- The terms for the following members of the advisory committee will expire in April of this year: Curt, Roger, Steve. They all expressed their interest in continuing to serve. As such, the committee voted unanimously to recommend their re-appointments for another two years.
- Chair Armbruster shared with the committee that the board for the lake level control structure was not installed by March 1, as stipulated by the court order. Chair Armbruster contacted ICDC, and the board was installed today (March 10). Chair Armbruster noted that the lake was slightly lower than normal, and the ice was all gone.

3C. PROJECT UPDATES

- Younes shared with the committee that the finance report discussed during February's meeting was off by \$18,000 on the revenue side, and the report had been updated accordingly.
- The lake consultant will be attending next month's meeting to go over this year's aquatic plan control program and to also discuss topics for the Spring newsletter.

3D. LLPOA DAM UPDATE

Susan informed the committee that the county's Board of Commissioners (BOC) did not approve the proposed Dam project Special Assessment District (SAD) during their meeting on February 24. However, there is another vote scheduled for tonight. Susan noted that the LLPOA will have several members in attendance this time to advocate for approval of the proposed SAD.
