12/16 1900 block of W. Grand River Ave., a report came in for three suspects accused of retail fraud. Witnesses on scene said they saw all three individuals running from security while simultaneously trying to conceal the items they had stolen. The suspects were caught in the parking lot and charged with retail fraud.

12/17 On the 5700 block of Pine Ridge, an individual reported a larceny from his property. Approximate cost of item is \$41.33. The victim knew the suspect and did not want to press charges.

12/18 4500 block of Sandown Court a victim reported identity theft. They claimed that someone had tried to apply for unemployment in their name. Report is on file.

12/19 Larceny from yard reported at 1700 block of Montgomery Ct. The victim states that their license plate had been stolen while they were out of town. They also believe the catalytic converter had been tampered with. No suspect identified.

12/21 Report of a larceny occurring on the 1800 block of Spring Lake Dr. The victim claimed that packages were stolen off their front porch. It was later discovered they were not in fact stolen. Another delivery driver moved them to a garage door for better concealment.

12/21 On the 3800 block of Dobie Rd., a caller reports a larceny. They state they were missing \$98. No suspects have been identified.

12/21 On the 1600 block of W. Grand River Ave., a report came in of a troublesome trespasser who was consuming alcohol in a store. Once confronted, the suspect was asked to leave and did so without issue. They have been trespassed from the establishment for a total of one year.

12/22 Larceny from automobile reported on the 2700 block of Hannah Blvd., victim states a pair of ear buds were stolen. Report on file.

12/23 Report of retail fraud on the 2000 block of W. Grand River Ave. Suspect was apprehended shortly after and claimed they stole the items to give as a gift to someone.

Total value of items stolen was approximately \$155.76. Suspect was ultimately released as the store did not want to press charges.

12/24 Retail fraud reported on the 1700 block of Newman Rd. Three suspects in total, two of which were seen and could be given a description. The third suspect is the driver and could not be fully described. They stole approximately \$354.99 worth of merchandise. Report is on file.

12/27 Report of a trespasser on the 5900 block of Marsh Road. The suspect had already been trespassed for life when entering the establishment. Suspect then began to drink alcohol left behind by previous restaurant patrons. Once police arrived, the suspect was arrested without issue.

12/28 On the 2700 block of E. Grand River Ave., an individual entered a restaurant and ordered food. Shortly after, the individual started yelling at staff and refused to leave the establishment. Subject has been trespassed for life.

12/29 Larceny report on the 4500 block of Comanche. Victim states they could not find their wallet that was last seen in their car. No suspect has been identified. Report is on file.

12/31 On the 2000 block of W. Grand River., a call came in for a trespasser who had caused a scene. Individual has been trespassed for one year.
