1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

3A. APPROVAL OF MARCH MEETING MINUTES

The draft March minutes were discussed and then were unanimously approved with one correction.

3B. CHAIRMAN REMARKS

- Chair Armbruster informed the committee that the Lake consultant will conduct their initial aquatic plant survey on May 6, and will plan on applying the first herbicide treatment during the week of May 19.

- Chair Armbruster shared with the committee that he requested analytic traffic data related to the lake's portal located on the Township's website.

3C. PROJECT UPDATES

Younes provided the following updates:

- Lift station project at the boat launch: The new lift station partial start up is scheduled for tomorrow (April 9). If all goes well, substantial completion will be achieved except for the new generator installation. The new generator installation & start up is planned after the new gas line installation, which is currently scheduled for next week. At this point, it appears that the boat launch could be available sometime next week for launching boats only but not parking.
- The sink hole that developed within Lake Drive just west of the boat launch has been repaired. However, Lake Drive will not open for traffic pending completion of related gas line replacement, new culvert installations by the County Road Department, road paving and slope restoration. At this point road opening is tentatively planned for April 23.

3D. LLPOA DAM UPDATE

Susan Andrews shared with the committee that the Dam committee will be meeting tonight at 7:00 regarding details of the Dam project's Special Assessment District (SAD). Related to this, Jim Folkening distributed copies of the "Alternative Analysis Review" completed by C2AE and dated February 13, 2025. It was noted that the county has requested that the LLPOA provide recommendations related to the SAD.

3E. PARK MANAGER REPORT

Park Manager Emens provided the following updates:

- The Lake Lansing County Park south parking lot will be paved this year.
- "EZ Launch" kayak dock will be installed at Lake Lansing county park south this year.

3F. 2025 LANDING BLITZ

Susan Andrews informed the committee that EGLE has determined that this year's campaign will be held between June 26th and July 6th. She suggested conducting the Lake Lansing's event on Sunday, July 6 from noon to 4. She then asked committee members for volunteers. Curt agreed, and Larry said he would if he's around and also he would offer his canopy if Ron was not available. Steve mentioned that he's also a "maybe". Susan mentioned that she'll follow up with Ron about his availability.
