Scheduled Harvester Notice

Week of August 25, 2025

Planned Harvesting: Progressive ae has engaged PLM to harvest Lake Lansing late in the week of August 25, 2025.

PLM as a company is very familiar with Lake Lansing. We have the new second harvester access site on Shaw Street completed, so the congestion at the boat ramp may not be as large an issue for the harvest period. We are working to minimize the issues, and also minimize costs and time.

The lake has been surveyed three times now, and the pesky milfoil is still very sparse. There is a significant but normal amount of Pond Weed, Elodea, and Starry Stonewort. The harvester will mainly deal with these plants, and will work mostly from the shoreline out 100 to 300 feet.

Please see attached map for expected harvesting areas.

We expect the harvesting to last approximately three to four days, depending on the weather.

We will continue to monitor and advise as necessary.


