

Interactive Map for Mobile Devices Uses Google Maps

Instructions for loading an Interactive Map that shows your position on Lake Lansing relative to the **DNR recommended Wake Boarding** areas and the **possible shallow areas** via an overlay on Google Maps on your Smart phone, Pad, or Laptop.


To load the interactive Wake boat and Shallows map overlay, it is best to have Google Maps already installed on your device. Then, just click on this link:


✗ Your Google Map should look like something like this:




✗ If you click on "View Map Legend", you will be able to read a description of the overlay, and you can turn on and off the red and blue areas and/or the depth contour lines by clicking on the check marks. That page looks like this:




✗ If your map does not show the Wake Zone Map and looks like this:




✗ You can bring up the Wake Zone Overlay by clicking on "you":
