07/16 1700 block of Newman Road for a retail fraud. The manager of the establishment was alerted to an individual passing all points of sale without attempting to pay for the merchandise. The suspect has not been identified. Report is on file.

07/17 1400 block of Donerail Place for a larceny report. The reporting victim states their catalytic converter had been stolen. No subjects had been identified. Report is on file.

07/18 1700 block of Newman Road for a larceny report. The victim who works at the establishment states they left their E-bike chained to a bike rack while working and came outside to notice it was stolen. The establishment does not have cameras on that side of the building, and no subject has been identified. Report is on file.

7/20 5100 block of Brookfield Drive for a fraud complaint. Caller states they had their banking information hacked and states that an unknown individual tried to persuade them to send them money to keep it private. No subject has been identified. Report is on file.

7/21 4800 block of Marsh Road for a larceny complaint. The victim, who works at this establishment, stated their bicycle had been stolen and replaced with a different one. The incident was caught on camera. Awaiting results from the security footage.

7/25 Call came into the lobby regarding a larceny complaint. The victim states they had a tool stolen from their truck bed while doing contract work for a company. The victim does not know who would have stolen the tool, and no subject has been identified. Report is on file.

The loss prevention manager of the establishment states that two unknown individuals entered the store, stole Legos, and proceeded to pass all points of sale without purchasing the merchandise. Awaiting video surveillance results for potential identification.
