Monday, August 3, 2026, at 4 pm is the deadline to request an absentee ballot in person, except for those who register to vote on Election Day. Those registering to vote on Election Day, August 4, 2026, are eligible to receive an Absent Voter Ballot at the Meridian Township Clerk's Office.

EARLY VOTING CENTER

All qualified electors in the Meridian Township Clerk's Office have the option to vote early in person, beginning Saturday, July 25th through Sunday, August 2nd, 2026.

On Saturday, July 25th, 2026, the Early Voting Center will be open from 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., due to preparation for the Celebrate Meridian Festival. Central Park Drive will be closed, and voters must enter through the Marsh Road entrance. Parking will be reserved for early voters.

From Sunday, July 26th through Sunday, August 2nd, 2026, the Early Voting Center will be open from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

The Election Commission must approve the establishment of an Absent Voter Counting Board, establish a Receiving Board, to set the date of the Public Accuracy Test, and designate the Clerk to conduct logic and accuracy tests of the electronic voting systems for the August 4, 2026 Primary Election, all subject to adjustments as necessary.

The deadline for public logic and accuracy test to be conducted is no later than July 20, 2026. Notice of accuracy test must be published at least 48 hours before test. (MCL 168.798). The legal ad is included below for your reference and will be published after approval. I would recommend the test be held on **July 17, 2026 at 3:00 pm** at the **Town Hall Room of the Meridian Township Municipal Building**.

Due to Early Voting being held in the Town Hall room, absent voter counting board pre-processing must be established at another location. We have reserved the Nokomis Cultural Heritage Center for the purpose of holding pre-processing. This location is in close proximity to the Clerk's Office and has ample space to carry out AVCB pre-processing duties.

The Election Commission must establish a Receiving Board by resolution. MCL 168.679a.
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The following motions should be considered:

"Move move to approve the Nokomis Cultural Heritage Center, 5153 Marsh Rd, Okemos, MI 48864, as the location for pre-processing and the Town Hall Room of the Meridian Township Municipality Building, 5151 Marsh Rd, Okemos, MI 48864 as the location of the absent voting counting boards for precincts 1-14 for the August 4, 2026 Primary Election.

"Move to designate the Clerk to conduct logic and accuracy tests and hold the August 4, 2026 Primary Election Public Accuracy Test on July 17, 2026 at 3:00 pm in the Town Hall Room of the Meridian Township Municipal Building, 5151 Marsh Rd, Okemos, MI, subject to adjustments as necessary by the Clerk."

The Election Commission is required to appoint Election Inspectors to serve in precincts, receiving board, and on the Absentee Voter Counting Board, all subject to adjustments as necessary.

Under MCL 168.764, the Election Commission is required to appoint for each election precinct and early voting site at least 3 election inspectors. MCL 168.674(1). These appointments must occur at least 21 days before each election, but in no case less than 5 days before the date for holding schools of instruction. MCL 168.674(1). From these appointees, the Election Commission is required to designate a chairperson for each precinct. MCL 168.674(2). An equal number, as nearly as possible, of election inspectors must be appointed from each major political party. MCL 168.674(2).

The Commission should appoint Election Inspectors at least 21 days before the August 4, 2026 Primary Election. This would be no later than July 14, 2026.

Election inspectors are listed below for Early Voting, Receiving Board, Absentee Counting Board, and Precincts for approval.

A. Appointment of Election Inspectors for Precincts, Early Voting, Receiving Board, Absentee Voter Counting Board

The following motion should be considered for appointment of the Election Inspectors for Precincts:
