- 10/1 On the 2800 block of East Grand River Avenue for trespass notification. A troublesome subject was identified and notified of a trespass from the business.
- 10/1 On the 1700 block of Newman Road for a retail fraud. Two unidentified suspects were observed stealing approximately \$745 worth of merchandise from the business. Investigation is ongoing.
