07/01 On the 1900 block of W. Grand River Avenue for a larceny from building report. Suspects opened the cash register and stole approximately \$170.00 in cash before exiting the building. Suspects have been identified and prosecution is being sought.

07/02 6100 block of Coach House Street for illegal use of credit card. The victim still had their credit card in the possession and was not sure how the suspect was able to use it. Approximate total of funds spent is \$220.00. Report is on file.

07/03 1900 block of W. Grand River Avenue for a trespassing complaint. Caller states that there was an aggressive and argumentative individual causing a scene to other patrons. Suspect has been trespassed for 90 days.

07/04 2700 block of Northwind Drive for a larceny. Victim states their electric bicycle was stolen after keeping it locked to a bike rack. The bicycle lock was nowhere to be found. Report is on file.

07/05 2200 block of W. Grand River Avenue for a larceny from automobile report. Victim states their vehicle's windows had been smashed through and items from the glove compartment are missing. Awaiting surveillance footage to be sent in for a follow up.

07/06 1900 block of W. Grand River Avenue for a larceny from automobile. Victim states they left their vehicle unlocked and was unable to give a description of the suspect. Approximately \$250.00 in cash was stolen. Report is on file.

07/07 1700 block of Newman Road for retail fraud. Suspects enter and exit the store without paying for merchandise. Approximate total of items stolen is \$75. Suspects have been identified and prosecution is being sought.

07/08 1900 block of W. Grand River Avenue for a retail fraud. Two suspects were seen on surveillance video stealing approximately \$780 worth of merchandise. Suspects have been identified and prosecution is being sought.

07/09 5900 block of Harvey Street for a fraud report. The victim states they were asked to sign a petition and when viewing the context on the phone, the victim saw all their personal information and immediately called to report the incident. No suspects have been identified. Report is on file.

07/10 3700 block of Chippendale Circle for a fraud report. The victim states that two unknown individuals on TikTok sent them two checks that they needed the victim to cash and then return to them into a specified account. The victim's bank recognized the checks as fraudulent right away and no money was ever given to the suspects. No suspects have been identified.

Once officers arrived, they escorted the individual out of the establishment and the suspect has since been trespassed for life.
