### **1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER**

Chair Armbruster called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm.

### **2. PUBLIC REMARKS**

### **3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

### **3A. APPROVAL OF MAY MEETING MINUTES**

The draft May minutes were discussed and then were unanimously approved with two minor corrections.

### **3B. CHAIRMAN REMARKS**

- Chair Armbruster shared with the committee an updated wake boat map, which included shallow shoals' areas designated as "no wake only".
- Chair Armbruster then briefly discussed this year's herbicide treatment, which involved the use of Flumioxazin. He indicated that this herbicide is relatively more cost effective than others that were used in recent years. He added that the lake consultant conducted a follow up survey after the treatment and noted that the treatment was very successful and recommended no additional treatment at this time. The consultant noted that native plants are slowly growing but not to a point

where harvesting is warranted. The consultant will be back out on the lake in about a month to reassess and survey for potential harvesting or additional treatment.

**3C. PROJECT UPDATES**

Younes provided the following updates:

- The summer newsletter is being developed, and a draft should be ready for review soon.
- The Township continues to work on minor restoration items related to the lift station project at the boat launch.
- The trenchless repairs for a couple of sewer sections upstream of the lift station are planned for some time in July. No significant disruption to the boat launch access is anticipated during this repair.

**3D. LLPOA DAM UPDATE**

Susan Andrews and Younes informed the committee that a draft Special Assessment roll has been developed for the dam project. Younes also shared with the committee that C2ae, the dam project consultant, has a tentative schedule to advertise for bids by the end of June with bid opening around July 21, and start of construction in the fall of this year with substantial completion by late December. The consultant indicated that the design is 90% complete, and they are currently working on securing all necessary easements and permits including permits from the State and soil erosion.

**3E. PARK MANAGER REPORT**

Park Manager Emens informed the committee that new signs at the park entrances will be completed within the next two weeks.

**4. ADJOURNMENT**

Chair Armbruster adjourned the meeting at 5:13 p.m.
