The following changes were made to the Meridian Charter Township 2026 Local Street Milling and Resurfacing Project specifications to include the adjustments of the cold milling HMA surface pay items. The Bidder will acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the appropriate space provided below and include this Addendum with their submitted bid. Failure to do so may result in disqualification of the bid.

Specifications

00 41 43 Bid Form (Page 17)

- The bid form has been adjusted to change the pay item **Cold Milling HMA Surface** to the new pay item **Cold Milling HMA Surface, Material Disposed** with a quantity of **61,290 Syd.**
- The bid form has been adjusted to include the new pay item **Cold Milling HMA Surface, Material Salvaged** with a quantity of **6,810 Syd.**

Special Provision – Cold Milling HMA Surface

- The special provision **Cold Milling HMA Surface** was added to the bid package to allow for the possibility of some excess millings to be delivered and stockpiled at the Meridian Township Department of Public Works Storage Yard.
- The following Measurement and Payment item were added:
 - **Cold Milling HMA Surface, Material Disposed.....Syd**
 - **Cold Milling HMA Surface, Material Salvaged.....Syd**

The following questions provide clarifications to the project specifications. The Bidder will acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the appropriate space provided on **Page 2** of this Addendum and include this Addendum with their submitted bid. Failure to do so may result in disqualification of the bid.

Questions

Q1: Who will take ownership of any millings taken offsite?

A1: The CONTRACTOR shall dispose and salvage millings as per the updated bid form. At the request of the Owner, the amount of salvaged material to be delivered may be increased or decreased from the contract amount, at the unit price per the bid form, up to the full amount of milled material as part of the work.

Q2: Is there a temporary storage location provided for extra millings if these materials are needed in other locations?

A2: If temporary storage for extra millings is needed, the CONTRACTOR will need to coordinate with Township staff in advance to ensure there is available space at the Township's yard located at 2100 Gaylord C Smith Court, Haslett, MI 48840.

Q3: Is there a description for each pay item?

A3: All pay item descriptions can be found in the MDOT 2020 handbook excluding the unique pay items listed in the "Unique Special Provisions" section of the 2026 Local Street Milling and Resurfacing bid package.

ARTICLE 4—TIME OF COMPLETION

- 4.01 Bidder agrees that the Work will be substantially complete and will be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions on or before the dates or within the number of calendar days indicated in the Agreement.
- 4.02 Bidder agrees that the Work will be substantially complete no later than September 25, 2026.
- 4.03 Bidder further agrees that the Work will be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions for each respective contract by October 9, 2026.
- 4.04 Bidder accepts the provisions of the Agreement as to liquidated damages.

5.01 *Bid Acceptance Period*

- A. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 90 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

5.02 *Instructions to Bidders*

ARTICLE 6—BIDDER'S REPRESENTATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS

6.01 *Bidder's Representations*

- A. In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents the following:
1. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, including Addenda.

2. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
3. Bidder is familiar with all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
4. Bidder has carefully studied the reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and the drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to the Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
5. Bidder has carefully studied the reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
6. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and the Technical Data identified in the Supplementary Conditions or by definition, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and Technical Data on (a) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (b) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, if selected as Contractor; and (c) Bidder's (Contractor's) safety precautions and programs.
7. Based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, Bidder agrees that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the performance of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Times, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract.
8. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
9. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and of discrepancies between Site conditions and the Contract Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Contractor.
10. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance and furnishing of the Work.
11. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

6.02 *Bidder's Certifications*

A. The Bidder certifies the following:

1. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation.
2. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid.
3. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding.
4. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 8.02.A:
 - a. Corrupt practice means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process.

- b. Fraudulent practice means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition.
- c. Collusive practice means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels.
- d. Coercive practice means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.

a. Description. This work shall be done in accordance with the requirements of section 501.03 of the MDOT 2020 Standard Specifications for Construction and as modified herein.

b. Materials. None Specified

c. Construction. Mill HMA and aggregate base to a depth of 4 inches from the top of the existing roadway surface. In locations where HMA thickness exceeds 4 inches, the contractor shall fully mill all existing HMA down to the gravel surface.

Salvaged millings shall be delivered and stockpiled properly at the Meridian Township Department of Public Works Storage Yard located at 2100 Gaylord C Smith Ct, Haslett, MI 48840. The price shall include removing, loading, hauling, and dumping at the specified location. The Township will have a loader and operator to move the millings around the storage yard.

At the request of the Owner, the amount of salvaged material to be delivered may be increased or decreased from the contract amount, at the unit price per the bid form, up to the full amount of milled material as part of the work. Any milled materials in excess of the amounts desired to be retained by the Township shall become the property of the contractor and properly disposed of at an off-site location.

d. Measurement and Payment. The completed work as described will be measured and paid for at the contract unit price using the following contract item (pay item):
