RE: Lac Du Mont Drive – 2025 Road Reconstruction Project

Dear Resident:

This notice is to inform you that Lac Du Mont Drive will be reconstructed from mid-July to mid- or late-August. The CATA bus route will be detoured on Bois Ile Drive during road reconstruction.

Lac Du Mont Drive will be reconstructed in two phases:

Phase I: From Lake Lansing Road to 2047 Lac Du Mont Drive

Phase II: Bios Isle Dr to 2047 Lac Du Mont Drive

Each phase will be closed to motorists and pedestrians during construction due to the nature of some of the construction activities that must be performed. Unfortunately, the need to close the road during construction could not be avoided.

Each phase should be closed to traffic and pedestrians for 2-3 weeks depending on how many rain days we experience. This means that if you live off of Lac Du Mont within Phase I, you will need to park at the north end of Phase II and walk to and from your condo/apartment in the green belt next to the road while Phase I is closed for construction. The same is true of Phase II when it is closed for construction.

To assist those in need, we will have two golf cart taxis staffed from Monday-Saturday from 7 a.m.-7 p.m. to shuttle you to and from your home/vehicle or the nearest CATA stop on Bois Isle Drive when needed. The golf carts will typically be stationed where Phase I and II meet near 2047 Lac Du Mont Drive. You can call the golf cart operators to request a ride at (773) 720-2715.

Due to the complexity of the construction logistics involved in this project, residents are highly encouraged to attend a virtual informational meeting on July 8 from 6 to 7 PM to learn more about this project:
