### **1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER**

Chair Armbruster called the meeting to order at **5:30 pm**.

### **2. PUBLIC REMARKS**

All members of the public present spoke of their interest in the lake and the work of the advisory committee.

#### **3A. Approval of Minutes**

The April 9, 2019 meeting minutes were approved as submitted.

#### **3B. Annual Public Meeting**

Chair Armbruster stated that he spoke with Steve Carpenter, President of the LLPOA, regarding the annual meeting. Mr. Carpenter requested the official SAD meeting follow the LLPOA meeting. As such, the committee unanimously agreed to hold the SAD meeting on June 4 at Lake Lansing Park South pavilion at 7:30. The committee requested the lake consultant be present to discuss the 2018 annual report, this year's aquatic plant control, the natural shoreland initiative on Lake Lansing, invasive species, and to answer any other questions related to the lake.

#### **3C. Herbicide Treatment**

The lake wide Fluridone application was completed on May 6, and the bump application is tentatively scheduled for May 28.

#### **3D. Miscellaneous**

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Coe Emens, Lake Lansing Park Manager, sent an email to Younes & Chair Armbruster that was shared with the committee. Coe provided the following in his email update:

- We are still researching the commercial withdrawal of water from the boat launch with our legal team and will continue with updating our rules after the holiday. Looking at end of June completion of Park Rules updates, so hopefully we will be able to restrict the commercial use of the boat launch soon.
- Old sign at boat launch removed. New one will be constructed this year when our FT staff gets caught up. Ian (new Assistant Manager) received signs from EGLE (DEQ) for invasives. We will also want to update the signage for the new washing rules - SAD taking care of this?
- The first application of Fluridone was completed.
- Planning on having buoys in at boat launch and swim area this week as well as the boat dock. Dock needed repairs and less than 5 mph winds to install.

Tim McCarthy stated that 92 goose eggs were collected so far this year.
