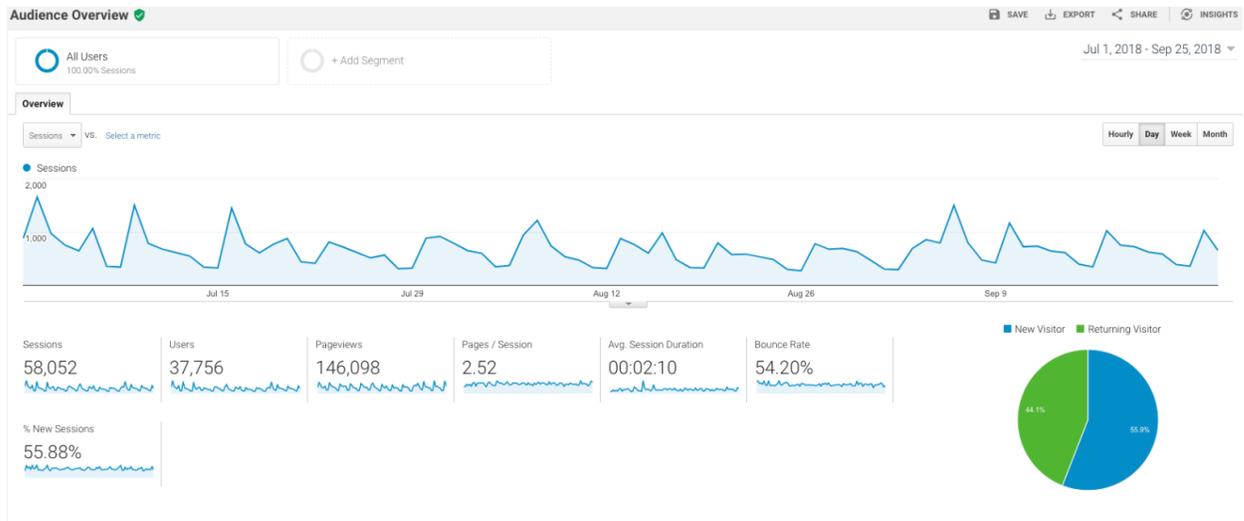

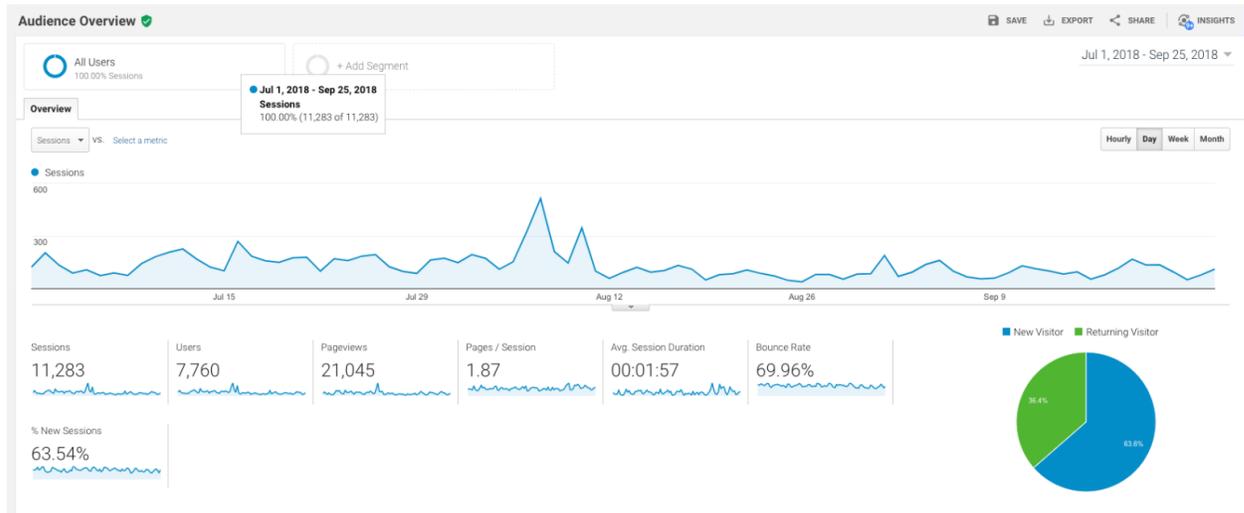
Meridian Township Website Audience Overview
