In lieu of a regular meeting during the month of July, the Land Preservation Advisory Board Members will be touring the Lake Lansing North Park. The Board Members will meet at the street intersection of Wild Ginger Trail and Woodwind Trail in Haslett at 7 pm.

The Board Members will visit and discuss recent and ongoing restoration projects in the park, including: deer resistant native plant garden at park entrance; natural communities and dominant native plants and invasive species threats; recent woodland prescribed burn and follow-up monitoring for deer browsing, light levels, and plant diversity; a prairie-oak savanna restoration; non-native phragmites control and a nearby native phragmites population.

This is solely a discussion/site tour event and although a quorum of the Land Preservation Advisory Board may be present, there will be no decisions made at this time. The site visit will be held rain or shine. Please appropriate trail footwear and mosquito repellent.
