

*The average 2023 Meridian Township residence generates an annual tax bill of \$6,335. This residence generates an annual \$3,104 toward local education, \$1,330 for county operations, \$1,267 for Township operations, \$380 for CATA, and \$191 for CADL, and \$63 for the airport.
